



LIFT ASSIST WAIVER

Joe's Club takes client and staff safety very seriously. While many of our clients can ambulate on their own, situations arise where a client cannot ambulate or needs assistances. The foundation must ensure that a policy is in place to ensure the safety of both the client and staff members.

Joes' Club members cannot require more than a two-person lift assist to the toilet; or ANY client-unassisted lift. The client must be able to "help." In a rare occasion that a client cannot offer any assistance when toileting, the following criteria must be established:

- Joe's Club does not have a Hoyer lift on-premises and is unable to toilet members that require more than a two-person lift assist.
- Members that are unable to be toileted due to lift assist may only attend Joe's Club for a maximum of 4 hours per day.
- Family/Caregiver must be able to pick member up within 30 minutes of being called in the event member experiences incontinence during this 4-hour period.

This pick-up policy is on place for both the hygiene of the client and the safety of our staff.

By signing below, I agree to each statement above and release the Brevard Alzheimer's Foundation from any and all liability for the unintentional harm due to incontinence from non-toileting.

Any non-compliance with this policy can be ground for immediate discharge.
